### SAFER MINISTRY TRAINING - JULY 2018

The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide requires all Parishes to comply with the Safer Ministry Program which aims to prevent abuse, and to respond effectively if it occurs.

**Whether you are a paid worker or a volunteer serving in ANY capacity within a church or related entity you must be screened and you must attend the appropriate training to apply for clearance.** The Program has 2 categories.

**Category 2** Covers people who are in any way representing the Parish as: Synod Representatives, Sacristans

Communion Assistants, Vergers

Anyone running any group whether on Church property or in a private home (eg Bible studies, meditation, knitting, sewing)

Welcomers, people working on church property inside building or out in grounds at any time,  
people working at the market etc.

**Everyone who is also covered by Category 1.**

**Category 1** Covers people who are: Clergy, Wardens

Parish Councillors, Any Office Holders, Lay Leaders

Anyone dealing with children, people with disabilities, people in grief or crisis (healing ministry), or older people. Anyone with access to information about any of the above.

**In order to be cleared for Safer Ministry you must attend the appropriate training session every 3 years and have a police National Criminal History Check.**

**There are 2 training dates coming up for our Parish to be held in the Hall at Crafers.**
